We received sad news this past week from members of our eWOOF family...

After a very sudden illness, **EDISON** (left) the Canaan Dog, was euthanized on Saturday, June 5th. Edison was owned by Nick Jurgens, a longtime eWOOF subscriber and supporter in Denver, who has also adopted two eWOOF dogs, Shawna from Casper and Cassie from Sheridan. Edison was adopted in 2006 from the Newcastle shelter (originally from the Casper shelter) and had a great life with Nick in Denver. He was just five years old and succumbed to a baffling and debilitating neurological affliction. We will miss receiving stories and pictures about Edison and 'the pack' and we extend our condolences to Nick.



We also learned that **GUS** (right), an aussie mix, 'took his final car ride' on Friday, June 4th. Gus belonged to Linda Wyatt in Sheridan, one our first eWOOF foster homes. Gus was adopted by Linda when she lived in Arizona. Gus had been found running at large in the small Arizona town and was taken to the local vet's office since there was no animal shelter. After a few days of 'no show' by the previous owner, Gus's time was up. Linda saved him at the last minute and he was her loving companion for many years. Gus was a friendly, gentle giant who loved 'his girls', Ida and Hot Rod the cats. He also easily welcomed several eWOOF foster dogs and all of Linda's friends' dogs into his home. Although we don't know his exact age, he was at least 15 years old and had a long, happy life with Linda. We miss him already.
